Summer Music Lesson Assistance Program

East Grand Rapids Middle/High School students may apply for assistance from the East Grand Rapids Music Boosters Association for private lessons, music seminars, or music camps (not including EGR band camp). These monies are made possible primarily through funds collected at the Scholarship Concerts, as well as the annual MBA Ham Sale.

Summer Music Lesson Assistance, for grades 6-11, is designated to enhance the instrumental or vocal class the student is enrolled in at school. Parents are asked to match the amount so that a meaningful number of lessons can be taken.

Music Seminars and Music Camp assistance are designated for tuition to programs such as the Western Michigan University music seminars, Interlochen and Blue Lake Music Camps, and Knollcrest Day Music Camp at Calvin College.

MBA assistance program is not for the EGR High School Marching Band camp, as the cost of this program is partially underwritten by MBA grants.

Assistance is granted to students who meet the following criteria:

- 1) Participation in the annual fall Ham Sale by selling at least \$25 in products.
- 2) Enrolled in band, orchestra, or vocal music at EGR Middle/High School during the current year.
- 3) Attend music camp or seminar, or take private lessons, that apply to the class enrolled in at school.
- 4) Register for vocal or instrumental music classes at EGR Middle/High School for the upcoming school year.
- 5) Answer and submit *Why Summer Music Lessons are Important to Me* in (3 – 5 sentences). Please attach and include with your application.

To apply for summer music lesson assistance from the East Grand Rapids Music Boosters Association, complete the application and follow the mailing and due date instructions. Students will receive notice of award in May by email with any necessary instructions.
